

FREE RESOURCES FOR PEER WORKERS

Peer workers have been at the forefront of the opioid crisis since the public health emergency was declared in response to a rise in illicit drug overdose deaths. In light of this, The Peer2Peer Project and BCCDC's Harm Reduction and Substance Use Services have developed free tools for peer workers, which can be found on the [Toward The Heart](#) website.

Peer Worker Leadership Training: Part of the BC Peer Worker Training Curriculum, these learning modules equip peer workers with leadership skills and tools for professional success.

Compassionate Action: An Anti-Stigma Campaign - A series of interactive case study videos about stigma and discrimination experienced by People Who Use Drugs (PWUD) and an accompanying reflection/discussion guide.
